The Central Valley Long Term Support and Services Coalition (CVLTSS) Coalition grew out of the expanded efforts of the Elder Abuse Prevention Roundtable (EAPRT). EAPRT started in 1997 with 15 participants. Today the Coalition includes members from protective agencies, social services agencies, legal services, senior services, private attorneys, and advocates. The Coalition's mission is to promote service coordination for dependent adults through a multidisciplinary approach to the development of programs that directly support workers handling older adult abuse cases. CVLTSS aims to work in partnership with those participants who remain committed to the EAPRT ideals, as well as additional organizations to inform and encourage providers and consumers to have a voice in statewide policy discussions.
