Formed in 2009, the Orange County Aging Services Collaborative (OCASC) promotes the importance of a person-centered, integrated system of services and supports that enables older adults to live more functional lives. OCASC members include nearly every nonprofit and governmental provider serving seniors in Orange County, acting as one coordinated voice to advocate on behalf of the county’s elderly population. As more individuals desire to age in place, OCASC focuses on the accessibility of quality doctors and services, as well as affordable long-term care options in their community. The Collaborative produces annual policy statements and organizes town hall forums, legislative breakfasts, and district visits to educate key stakeholders on the needs of seniors in Orange County.
