

Overview of NQF

What is the National Quality Forum (NQF)?

NQF is an independent, nonprofit, membership organization that brings together all stakeholders working to improve health and healthcare through quality measurement.

NQF World



How Does NQF Improve Quality?

- Reviews, prioritizes, and endorses measures
- Recommends measures for federal programs
- Serves as a trusted advisor to the U.S. government on federal policy development
- Identifies what works and what doesn't in measurement
- Identifies measure gaps
- Accelerates measure development

- Identify promising measurement areas for further examination, drawing from at least one of the essential attributes
- Identify exemplar communities who are using data and/or measures to improve services and supports

Case Studies Project: Lessons Learned

- Previous NQF Work
 - Home and Community-Based Services (consumer voice)
- Key Informants
 - Pressing need for measure development in this area
- Overall themes:
 - Many communities are using data in innovative ways
 - Data-sharing capabilities vary
 - Community collaboration is essential
 - Medically-oriented outcomes dominate
 - **Great opportunities for growth in measure development

Growing measurement complexity




Major barriers to measurement innovation

- Major
 measurement gaps
 across healthcare
- Not consistently achieving measures that matter (outcomes, resource use, patient-centered)

- Methodological challenges
- Informatics challenges
- Clinical challenges
- Patient-centered challenges

- Expensive
- Time-consuming
- Difficult to access appropriate test beds for innovative measures


